UPC DRESS CODE

General Event Dress Code

Note

This dress code applies to all events other than:

- (a) Student Eight-ball Pool Home Internationals – Trials (see below)
- (b) Student Eight-ball Pool Home Internationals – Championships (see below)

Unless specified otherwise, players must be dressed according to the following specification:

Male: formal collared shirt or polo shirt; waistcoats are permitted if worn over a formal collared shirt; full length trousers and shoes.

Female: formal collared shirt or blouse, polo shirts or skinny top; waistcoats are permitted if worn over a formal collared shirt or blouse; full-length trousers or knee length skirt and shoes.

Team members: team members are strongly encouraged to wear matching tops that fall within the generic dress code.

Strictly not permitted: any hooded top, any form of hat or cap.

Definitions

Shirts: formal collared shirts and polo shirts only. No T-shirts or sports jerseys of any kind. The shirts must be substantially plain and may not bear any writing or insignia on their fronts or sleeves other than the institutional crest and/or name. A sponsor's logo and/or name is also permitted. On the reverse the players name and number may be written, the name may take nickname form provided that it is not deemed to be offensive by the Tournament Director. A sponsor's logo and/or name is also permitted. No sports jerseys.

Trousers: full-length trousers must be worn. Tracksuit bottoms or similar are not allowed, otherwise, style is discretionary.

Shoes: style is discretionary

The dress code applies to both players involved in any frame. Players failing to comply with the dress code will forfeit their current frame and one successive frame for each five minutes that they do not conform to the dress code.

If any individual or team captain is in doubt as to the interpretation of any of these stipulations, they are advised to contact the Tournament Director **prior** to the event or at the earliest opportunity.

The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final as regards to whether a player conforms to the dress code.

Student Eight-ball Pool Home Internationals - Trials

Players must be dressed according to the following specification:

Male: formal collared shirts or polo shirts; waistcoats are permitted if worn over a formal collared shirt; black tailored trousers and black shoes.

Female: formal collared shirts/blouse or polo shirts; waistcoats are permitted if worn over a formal collared shirt/blouse; black tailored trousers; black tailored trousers or knee length black skirt and black shoes.

Strictly not permitted: any hooded top, any form of hat or cap.

Definitions

Shirts: formal collared shirts or polo shirts which must be plain. The shirts may not bear any writing or insignia on their fronts or sleeves other than the institutional crest and/or name. A sponsor's logo and/or name is also permitted. On the reverse the players name and number may be written, the name may take nickname form provided that it is not deemed to be offensive. A sponsor's logo and/or name is also permitted. No T-shirts or sports jerseys.

Trousers: black tailored trousers must be worn. No studs, no combat styles, no jeans, no tracksuit or jogging bottoms.

Shoes: black, no trainers, no smart-casual shoes.

Players failing to comply with the dress code will forfeit their current frame and one successive frame for each five minutes that they do not conform to the dress code.

The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final as regards whether a player conforms to the dress code.

Student Eight-ball Pool Home Internationals - Championships

Players will be provided with a team top. In addition all players must be dressed according to the following specification:

Male: black tailored trousers and black shoes.

Female: black tailored trousers or knee length black skirt and black shoes.

Strictly not permitted: any hooded top, any form of hat or cap.

Definitions

Trousers: black tailored trousers must be worn. No studs, no combat styles, No jeans, no tracksuit or jogging bottoms.

Shoes: black, no trainers.

The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final as regards whether a player conforms or does not conform to the dress code.

Players must adhere to the dress code at all times during the competition whether playing or not. Players failing to comply with the dress code will forfeit their current frame and one successive frame for each five minutes that they do not conform to the dress code.

Players must not wear the team tops outside of the competition until the competition has been declared closed.
