Accommodation

It is compulsory for all participants and supporters to stay in Vauxhall Holiday Park for the duration of our event.

Check in: Thursday 25 February from 13h00.

Check out: Sunday 28 February by 15h00.

Deposit: £20 per individual payable on arrival by cheque, cash or credit card.*

The caravans offer comfortable living space with facilities such as satellite television, fully fitted kitchen and bathroom. Crockery and cutlery will be provided in the accommodation, as will bed linen.

A complimentary electricity card will be issued on check-in which should be sufficient for normal usage of lighting, heating and hot water during your stay. Additional cards are available from reception for a small charge.

Regency Room

All competition matches will be played in the Regency Room. There will be 36 Supreme pool tables in this room within a defined playing area, surrounded by a defined spectator area, and these tables will be available for practice prior to the event commencing, at players' personal expense. The Regency Room offers full bar facilities.

Additional facilities

- Sports Bar and Games Room with 4 snooker tables and 20 pool tables (available for practice for duration of weekend at players' personal expense).
- Amusement arcade.
- Shop, offering newspapers and snacks.

Food

There are multiple catering options available on-site:

- *Americana*: Burgers & fried chicken;
- *Jade*: Kebabs;
- *Giovanni's*: Pizzas & jacket potatoes;
- *Ocean Drive*: Fish & chips;
- *Shop*: Newspapers & snacks

* By staying in Vauxhall Holiday Park, each individual must abide by the park's booking terms and conditions. The deposit will be returned following a satisfactory inspection of the accommodation on check-out. **The UPC will not get involved in any dispute relating to the return of deposits.**
